JUDGMENT

1. This case is instituted upon the final report submitted by the State of Kerala (Police) alleging commission of offence punishable U/Sec 15(c),63 of ABKARI (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1969 .

2. Accused appeared through counsel. Copies of all relevant records produced by the prosecution were furnished to the counsel. Particulars of offence read over and explained to the counsel for the accused, to which he pleaded guilty on behalf of the accused. I am satisfied that the plea of guilty is voluntary.

4. Plea of guilty is accepted and on the basis of the plea accused are found guilty of the offence punishable u/s. 15 (c) of Kerala Abkari Act and convicted u/s. 252 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973. Counsel for the accused pleaded for leniency on punishment.

3. I am satisfied that this is not a fit case to invoke the benevolent provisions of the Probation of Offenders Act. Considering the nature and gravity of the offence accused are sentenced to pay fine of Rs.500 /- each for the offence punishable u/s. 15 (c) of Kerala Abkari Act. In default of payment of fine accused have to undergo simple imprisonment for one week each.
