ORDER

This is a petition filed u/s. 497 of B.N.S.S for the interim custody of a mobile phone involved in crime No. 816/2025 of Nenmara Police Station.

2. The averments in the petition are that the petitioner is the fourth accused in the abovesaid case. The offences alleged against the accused are punishable u/ss. 112(2) of B.N.S, u/s. 20 (b) (ii) A, 25, 29 and 27 (b) of N.D.P.S Act and u/s.77 of J.J Act. The mobile phone belonging to the petitioner/accused No.4 was seized by the respondent and produced before the court as serial No.2 in item No.736/2025. Hence, he filed this application for interim custody of the above-mentioned article.

3. Copy served to the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor. The Sub Inspector of Police, Nenmara Police Station, has filed a report objecting the release of the mobile phone.

4. Heard both sides.

5. The petitioner claims that his mobile phone was seized by the respondent and was produced before the court and entered as serial No.2 in item No.736/2025. I am satisfied that the petitioner is the owner of the mobile phone. The mobile phone, being an electronic gadget, keeping it idle may damage it. Hence, interim custody of the mobile phone is given to the petitioner, subject to the conditions mentioned below;

1. The petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of ₹.1,00,000/- (One lakh rupees) along with two solvent sureties each for the like sum.
2. The petitioner shall produce photographs of the mobile phone and produce the same along with CD. The photographs should be duly attested by the petitioner and his counsel before the Chief Ministerial Officer.
3. The petitioner shall produce the certificate of the photographer u/s.63 of Bharatiya Sakshya Adhinyam, 2023.
4. The petitioner shall produce the mobile phone as and when required by

the court to do so.

5. On compliance of the above conditions, release the mobile phone after preparing a proper panchanama.
