This Execution Petition coming on for hearing on 31.03.2026 and  
the Court on the same day passed the following:-

**ORDER**

Decree Holder and Judgment Debtor 1 and 2 absent, no  
representation. On 03.06.2025, decree holder absent, no representation,  
Judgment Debtor 1 and 2 absent, represented, the court ordered to verify

whether stay order extended and posted to 30.06.2025. On 30.06.2025, decree holder absent, represented. The court again ordered to verify whether stay order extended and posted to 15.07.2025. On 15.07.2025, decree holder absent, no representation, Judgment Debtor 1 and 2 absent, represented. The court again ordered to verify whether stay order extended and posted to 13.08.2025. On 13.08.2025, there was no representation from both sides. The court issued notice to decree holder and Judgment Debtor 1 and 2 and ordered to verify whether stay order extended and posted to 27.08.2025. On 27.08.2025, decree holder absent represented, but Judgment Debtor-1 and Judgment Debtor-2 called absent, no representation. The court again ordered to verify whether stay order extended and posted to 30.09.2025. On 30.09.2025, the case was adjourned by notification to 06.10.2025. On 06.10.2025, decree holder absent, no representation. Judgment Debtor 2 absent, represented, no order of stay produced. On verification, it is found that an extended order of stay dated 12.06.2024 produced in this case. Judgment Debtor 2 is directed to file affidavit stating whether there is any extended order of stay of the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala and posted to 30.10.2025. On 30.10.2025, decree holder and Judgment Debtor 1 and 2 absent, no representation, no order of stay produced. Case posted to 31.12.2025. On 31.12.2025, there was no sitting and the case was adjourned by notification to 13.01.2026. On 13.01.2026, decree holder and Judgment

Debtor 1 and 2 absent, no representation, no order of stay produced and case posted to 12.03.2026. On 12.03.2026, there was no representation from both sides, no order of stay produced. The case posted for further steps to 23.03.2026. On 23.03.2026, both parties absent, no further steps taken and posted to 31.03.2026. On 23.03.2026 the court directed the bench clerk of this court to ascertain through the concerned section of the Hon'ble High Court that whether there is any extended order of stay. He called the section concerned and ascertain that there is no extended order of stay. Today also no representation for both parties when the case called in roll call. No further steps taken. Case kept aside and called again at 4.45 PM, no representation for both parties, no further steps taken. Hence Execution Petition dismissed.
