and on the same day the court passed the following:-

**ORDER**

Proceedings U/s 446 of Cr.P.C

Counter Petitioners

- (1) : Vinod,  
S/o Gangadharan,  
Mannarakodu House,  
Kidangannur,  
Pathanamthitta.
- (2) : Chellamani,  
W/o Nanu,  
Sneha Bhavanam (Pulimoottil),  
Kadammanitta Muri,  
Elanthoor village.

The counter petitioners are the sureties of the accused namely Ratheesh Kumar @ Saneesh in SC No.13/2022 pending before this Court, who was released on bail by executing a bail bond for Rs.50,000/- each on 08.10.2021.

2. The bail bond binds the counter petitioners to produce the accused before the Court as and when required. By the bail bond, the counter petitioners are liable to be forfeited to the Government of Kerala, a sum of Rs.50,000/- each in case of default of the accused to appear before the Court.

3. The accused absconded and consequently the bail bond was forfeited and notices were issued to the counter petitioners calling upon them to show cause why penalty should be imposed upon them. Despite receipt of the notices, the counter petitioners did not turn up and showed any sufficient cause against imposing the penalty and hence, it is found that, the counter petitioners are liable to pay the bond amount as penalty. Accused still remains absconding and hence, it is found that, the counter petitioners are liable to pay a sum of Rs.50,000/- each as penalty on account of the forfeiture of the bail bond.

**In the result**, CP1 and CP2 are ordered to pay a penalty of Rs.50,000/- each.
