This is a case having been finally heard on 23/04/2026, the Court on the same day delivered the following:-

ORDER

1. ***The accused faces indictment for offences punishable under sections 341, 323, 325, 332 and 333 r/w section 34 of the Indian Penal Code., as per Crime No. 790/2023 of Pulikeezhu Police Station.***
2. ***The prosecution case is that, on 08/10/2023 at 16.00 hours., accused Nos.1 to 4 with intent to deter CW1 to CW3 from the discharge of their official duty and when CW2 had tried to apprehend the 2nd accused who tried to flee from the place of occurrence, he had caught hold of his neck and pushed him. When CW1 had tried to apprehend the 1st accused, the 1st and 4th accused had twisted his left hand causing fracture to his index finger. The 3rd accused had pushed CW3 who had attempted to apprehend him. Thereby the accused had committed the aforesaid offences.***

3. On filing of the final report, court took cognizance of the offences punishable under sections 341, 323, 325, 332 and 333 r/w section 34. Initially this case was taken on file as CC 363/2024. On verification it is seen that the offence under section 333 of the Indian Penal Code is triable by Hon'ble Court of Sessions. Therefore case is renumbered as CP 07/2026. On appearance of the accused before the court, copies of all the prosecution records were furnished to them in compliance of section 230 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita. The 1st accused in the instant case is undergoing custody in another crime and was produced before this court on production warrant.
4. On perusal of the case records, it is seen that accused are on bail and the offences alleged against them are exclusively triable by the Hon'ble Court of Sessions. Therefore, the following order is passed:-

- i. The case is committed to Hon'ble Court of Session, Pathanamthitta as per Sec. 232 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita.*
- ii. Accused are on bail. They are directed to appear before Hon'ble Court of Session, Pathanamthitta on receipt of summons from the Court.*
- iii. Case records shall be forwarded to the Hon'ble Court of Sessions, Pathanamthitta and the properties produced, if any, shall be sent subject to Rules 77(2) of Criminal Rules of Practice, Kerala.*
- iv. The committal of the case shall be notified to the learned Public Prosecutor, Pathanamthitta.*
