

Case taken on today's board as per advancement application filed by counsel for Jdr. Sri. H.Murugendrappa filed vakalath on behalf of Jdr Iffco - Tokio General Insurance Co. and filed appn U/O. 9 Rule 7 r/w sec. 151 of CPC seeking an order to set aside the exparte order passed against Jdr. This appn is supported by memo of facts by the counsel for Jdr. Perused the memo of facts, satisfied with the reasons stated in the memo of facts. Hence appn filed U/O. 9 Rule 7 r/w sec. 151 of CPC is allowed and exparte order passed against Jdr is set aside. The counsel for petr Sri. LHP adv is present. The counsel for Jdr filed memo stating that Jdr has paid the entire award amount of Rs. 8 lakh . It is stated an amount of Rs. 4,80,000/- is deposited to Dhr account bearing No. 1132110010056258 maintained at Ujjivan Small Finance Bank and Rs. 3,20,000/- is deposited before the court. The Dhr counsel submitted that entire EP amount is paid by the Jdr and he filed memo under his signature stating that Jdr has paid the entire amount awarded in ECA. No. 19/2020 and prayed to close the petition as fully satisfied. Hence, in view of memo this execution petition is closed as fully satisfied and the order of attachment of movables of Jdr issued on 28.10.2022 is recalled.
