This petition having been finally heard on 17.04.2026 having stood over for consideration to this day, the Court passed the following:

**ORDER**

Petition filed u/s. 480(5) of the BNSS.

2. This petition is filed by Public Prosecutor and respondent is the Accused No.2 in the above Sessions case. According to the petitioner, bail was granted to A2 in CrI.M.P. 659/2022 on 03.03.2022 on a condition that petitioners will not get involved in any other offence while on bail. When this condition was in force,

A2 was involved in crime 157/2024, which was registered u/s. 22(c) & 29 of NDPS Act. Hence the bail order granted in this case may be recalled as the petitioner violated condition.

3. It is seen that no objection was filed by respondent so far eventhough notice was given to the counsel appearing for respondent.

4. The allegation against respondent is that during the pendency of bail condition, this accused was involved in crime 157/2024 of Kunnamkulam Police Station wherein the offences registered was u/s. 22(c) & 29 of the NDPS Act. This accused was A1 in that crime. FIR copy of crime 157/2024 along with search list was produced by the prosecution. As per the averments in FIR, during a search conducted in House No.18/201 of Choondal Panchayath, accused was inside the house along with a another person named Nithin. MDMA was found from a wooden shelf fixed on the southern wall of a room in the house. It is seen that owner of the house was Hajira, W/o Haneefa. This accused is the son of Haneefa. That means, accused was residing in that house. The materials available before this court shows that accused was got involved in an another NDPS case inspite of obtaining bail on condition in Crl.M.P. 659/2022 that he shall not involve in any other offences while on bail. There is willful violation of bail condition. Hence petition is allowed and bail granted in Crl.M.P. 659/2022 is recalled.

In the result, petition is allowed and bail granted to accused in Crl.M.P.

659/2022 is recalled. Issue NBW to accused.
