1. The first respondent is directed to provide an alternate accommodation on rent either a house or apartment within one month from the date of order, the rent of the house or apartment shall be borne by him
2. The first respondent is directed to pay a monthly maintenance amount of RS. 1000/- to the petitioner per month and Rs. 1000/- to the child per month in addition to the amount already awarded by the honourable family court as per the compromise order in MC 268/2009 and MC 199/2011. The maintenance amount will be payable from the date of order.
3. The first respondent is directed to pay Rs. 2 Lakhs as compensation to the petitioner within one month from the date of order failing which he will be liable to pay 8% interest per annum till realisation.
4. Other reliefs prayed in the petition is not granted and there is no relief granted against respondents number 2 to 5
