Plea of the accused : Pleading guilty under Section 20(b)(ii) A of
the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic
Substances Act, 1985.

Finding of the Judge : Guilty under section 20(b)(ii) A of the
Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances
Act, 1985.

Sentence or Order : The accused is sentenced under section 20(b)
(ii) A of the NDPS Act, to undergo simple
imprisonment till rising of the court and to
pay a fine of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees five
thousand only) or in default, to undergo
simple imprisonment for 30 days.

The Sessions Case having been finally heard on 09.06.2026 in the presence of counsel appearing for either side and having stood for consideration till this day, the court delivered the following.

JUDGMENT

This is a case chargesheeted by Sub Inspector of Police, Kodungallur Police Station alleging offences under Section 20(b)(ii) A of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 and Section 77 of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act.

2. The case of the prosecution is that, the accused person was found in possession of 70 grams of dried cannabis sativa, a narcotic drug, on 11.09.2017 at 9.25 a.m, Kerala Varma Higher Secondary School Junction, Eriyad near the Fathima Saidumammed Memorial waiting shed and the prosecution states that the accused had been engaged in the sale of the narcotic to the school children. Therefore the offences.

3. The case originated from crime No.1666/2017 of Kodungallur Police Station. The case was investigated by the Sub Inspector of Police, Kodungallur Police Station. The charge sheet was laid by him.

4. The case had been primarily filed before the Magistrate Court as per CP 45/2023 of JFCM, Kodungallur and charge was filed against the accused on that basis. As it is found that the offence is triable exclusively by the Court of Session, the case was committed to the Sessions Court, Thrissur. It was numbered as SC 568/2023. Later, the matter was committed to this court, as this court was being constituted as the Children's Court.

5. The accused person is present today. As per separate order dated 09.06.2026, the accused is discharged of the offence under section 77 of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act. Therefore, a charge has been framed against him under section 20(b)(ii)(A) of the Narcotic Drugs and

Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, the accused pleads guilty to the charge when the charge is read over and explained to him in Malayalam.

6. His plea is recorded and it is found to be voluntary, and is therefore accepted.

7. The accused person is convicted under section 20(b)(ii)(A) of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 and his bail bond is cancelled.

8. The accused is heard on the question of sentence. He states that he is aged 63 years right now. He is not to be convicted in any other cases. There is no such case for the prosecution even. He prayed for leniency on the sentence.

9. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also the quantity of the contraband, the accused is therefore entitled for some leniency. The accused is sentenced under section 20(b)(ii) A of the NDPS Act, to undergo simple imprisonment till rising of the court and to pay a fine of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees five thousand only) or in default, to undergo simple imprisonment for 30 days.
