This petition has come up before me for hearing on this day the court passed the following:-

**ORDER**

This application for bail is filed u/s.483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 by the accused.

2. According to the counsel for the petitioner/accused, the prosecution allegations levelled against the petitioner are false and unfounded. The petitioner is totally innocent of the allegations levelled against him. It is contended that he did not attack the defacto complainant and he was falsely implicated based on mere assumptions and conjecture. In the event of granting bail, the accused is ready to abide any conditions that may be imposed by this Court on him. Hence, he prayed for bail.

3. Notice is given to the Additional Public Prosecutor.

4. Heard the counsel for the petitioner/accused and the Additional Public Prosecutor and perused the records.

5. According to the counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner/accused is totally innocent of the allegation levelled against him. It is contended that the petitioner/accused did not attack the defacto

complainant and he was falsely implicated based on mere assumptions and conjecture. In the event of granting bail, the petitioner/accused is ready to abide any conditions that may be imposed by this Court on him. Considering the entire facts, I am inclined to grant bail on conditions.

6. In the result, bail application is allowed and the accused shall be released on bail on the following conditions: -

(1). The accused shall execute a bond for ₹1,50,000/- with two solvent sureties each for the like sum to the satisfaction of the court.

(2). The accused shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement threat or promise to any persons acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or tamper with the evidence of witnesses.

(3). The accused shall not commit any offence similar to the offence of which he is the accused while on bail.
