2. Notice served on defendants. Defendants entered appearance
and filed written statement. Court framed issues and suit posted for
pretrial steps. On the request of parties, the matter was referred to
mediation as per Section 89 of the Code of Civil Procedure. In the
mediation, the parties settled the matter and they entered into a

mediation agreement dated 04.03.2026. All the issues were discussed and settled between the parties in mediation.
