Offence : U/s.126(2),115(2),118(1),333,351(3),110,3(5) of BNS.

Finding : Exclusively triable by Court of Sessions.

Sentence or Order : Case is committed to the Hon'ble Sessions Court,
Thrissur. Case against 2nd accused is refiled as CP
66/2026.

This case having been heard finally on the 30th day of March 2026 the
court on the same day delivered the following:-

COMMITTAL ORDER

1. This case is taken on file upon a final report filed by the Sub
Inspector of Police, Kodakara Police Station in Crime No. 880/2025 of
that police station against the accused alleging offences punishable
under sections 126(2),115(2),1118(1),333,351((3),78,79,110,3(5) of BNS.

2. The prosecution allegation against the accused is as follows:-

On 13-11-2025 at 06:45 hours, accused due to previous animosity, trespassed in to the house of defacto complainant at Vasupuram desom, and uttered filthy words against the wife of the defacto complainant. 1st accused intimidated to kill the defacto complainant and his son. Accused caught hold on the shirt collar of the defacto complainant and pushed him down. When the defacto complainant stand up from there, 1st accused hit him with knuckle duster on his neck and back. When the defacto complainant obstructed the accused, accused forcefully hit him with knuckle duster on his head. The defacto complainant evaded it and thereby he sustained injury on his forehead. At the same time, 2nd accused pushed and caught hold the defacto complainant. Had the defacto complainant not evaded the attack with knuckle duster to his head, it would have caused injuries to his vital parts and may resulted into his death. Thus, the accused are alleged to have committed the aforementioned offences.

3. 2nd accused is absconding. 1st accused is on bail. Copies of all the relevant prosecution records were furnished to the 1st accused u/s. 230 of BNSS. After hearing both sides and on perusal of the records it is noticed that the offences alleged to be committed by the accused herein are exclusively triable by a Court of Sessions. Hence the case is committed to the Hon'ble Court of Sessions, Thrissur u/s. 232 (a) BNSS.

4. The 1st accused is directed to appear before the Hon'ble Sessions Court, Thrissur as and when directed.

5. Submit the entire records of the case and documents to the Hon'ble Sessions Court, Thrissur u/s. 232 (c) BNSS.

6. The committal of the case shall be notified to the Public Prosecutor u/s. 232 (d) BNSS.

7. Case against 2nd accused is split up and refiled as CP 66/2026.
