ORDER

1. This petition is filed by the petitioner who is the 5th accused in **CC 1218/2014**, seeking no objection for her securing a passport and to travel abroad.
2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned APP. Perused the records. Report filed.
3. The sole point that arises for consideration in this petition is whether permission can be granted to the petitioner to secure the passport and to travel abroad?
4. Considering the judgments of the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala in *Mohamad Shafi v. Regional Passport Officer* : 2017 (2) KHC 484 : 2017 (1) KLD 631 : 2017 (2) KLT 309; *S. K. Asok Kumar v. State of Kerala*: 2009 KHC 557 : 2009 (2) KLT 712 and Notification No. GSR. 570(E) dated 25.08.1993 of the External affairs ministry, I am of the view that the pendency of this case shall not stand in the way of the petitioner obtaining a passport, if she is otherwise entitled to obtain the same. The petitioner is therefore permitted to secure a passport with a short validity of **three years** and to travel abroad.
