ORDER

1. This petition is filed U/s 205 of Cr.P.C to exempt the 7th accused from appearing before the court.
2. The petitioner is the 7th accused in CC 352/2019 on the files of this court.
3. The petitioner submitted that he will not dispute his identity. According to the petitioner, as he has to go abroad for job, he prayed for getting permission to avoid his personal attendance during trial.
4. Heard. Perused the records. The prosecution has no cogent objection to the petition.
5. Petitioner has stated that he will not dispute identity at trial. On a perusal of records and on hearing, I am satisfied that the personal appearance of the petitioner is not necessary at this stage. Therefore, the petitioner is exempted from appearing before the Court and permitted to go abroad. It is directed that the petitioner will appear before the court as and when required. Petitioner shall be represented by his counsel on all postings. The counsel for the accused shall act for and on behalf of the petitioner for the purpose of framing of charge/recording plea, 313 examination and for the remaining proceedings associated with trial. The counsel for the accused shall file a special vakalath for the petitioner contenting these facts.
6. In the result, the petition is allowed.
