**ORDER**

1. This petition is filed by the petitioner who is the accused in **CC 1101/2021**, seeking no objection for renewing his passport.
2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned APP. Perused the records. Report filed.
3. The sole point that arises for consideration in this petition is whether permission can be granted to the petitioner to renew his passport ?
4. Considering the judgments of the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala in *Mohamad Shafi v. Regional Passport Officer* : 2017 (2) KHC 484 : 2017 (1) KLD 631 : 2017 (2) KLT 309; *S. K. Asok Kumar v. State of Kerala*: 2009 KHC 557 : 2009 (2) KLT 712 and Notification No. GSR. 570(E) dated 25.08.1993 of the External affairs ministry, I am of the view that the pendency of this case shall not stand in the way of the petitioner obtaining a passport, if he is otherwise entitled to obtain the same. The petitioner is therefore permitted to renew his passport with a short validity of **three years**.
