ORDER IN CMP. 1/2026

This is a petition filed by the defacto complainant for further investigation.

2. The averments in the petition is that he is the injured and CW1 in the case. The case of the petitioner is that on 02.11.2019 he was wrongfully restrained by the accused and was beaten with hand and also stamped with legs wearing shoes on his stomach and chest. Thereafter he was admitted at Govt. Hospital, Kunnamkulam and thereafter he was referred to Medical college hospital for scanning and better treatment. On examination it was found that there are injuries to his head and stomach. He had given his statement to S.I of Guruvayoor police station on 03.11.2019. He had stated about his treatment at Govt. Medical College. However the investigation officer had not collected the medical records from Govt. Medical College nor had taken statement of the doctor who had treated him. The police had not properly investigated the case. Therefore, it is highly necessary to conduct further investigation.

3. Heard. Perused. This is a case in which the charge is already framed and the trial has proceeded with and CW1 has been examined. The petitioner has filed this petition only after commencement of trial. The case is of the year 2019. The petitioner has not explained why the petition was not filed earlier. Hence, it is satisfied that the only intention of the defacto complainant is to drag the proceeding. It is also found that if this petition is allowed it will cause undue hardship to the

accused. Further, it is trite law that a petition for further investigation is not maintainable after framing of charge and commencement of trial. Hence the petition is dismissed.
