ORDER

1. This is a petition filed by the RC owner of the vehicle bearing registration No. KL-46-G-6300 seeking custody of RC Book of the said vehicle seized in crime No. 849/2022 of the Vadanappally police station.
2. Heard both sides. Perused records. The prosecution has reported that the petitioner is the RC owner of the vehicle and that the RC of the said vehicle is seized and produced before the court. Invariably, the RC of the vehicle is necessary for daily use. I am of the opinion that the detention of the original RC in custody of the court is not required for the case at hand and that the purpose sought to be achieved can be attained through a certified copy of the said RC Book. In such circumstances, I am of the opinion that this petition can be allowed on conditions. The petition is allowed as follows.
 - i. The petitioner shall execute a bond for ₹ 10,000/- with one solvent surety for the like sum, for return of RC, if so directed.
 - ii. The petitioner shall produce certified copy of the RC Book to be kept in file, instead of the original RC Book.
 - iii. The original RC shall be released to the petitioner on compliance of the above conditions.
