- Offence : U/s. 189(2), 191(2), 190, 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 110, 351(2), 296(b) of BNS.
- Finding : The offences are exclusively triable by the Hon'ble Sessions Court, Thrissur.
- Order : The case of accused is committed to the Hon'ble Sessions Court, Thrissur for trial U/s. 232(a) of BNSS.

This case having been heard finally on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2026 the court on the same day delivered the following:-

**ORDER**

1. This case is taken on file upon a final report filed by the Sub Inspector of Police, Guruvayoor Temple Police Station in Cr. No.912/2025 of that Police Station, against the accused alleging offences punishable under sections 189(2), 191(2), 190, 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 110, 351(2), 296(b) of BNS.

2. The prosecution case in brief is that, on 01/12/2025 at 11.30 p.m., at Mallisseriparambu, the accused nos. 1 to 5, in furtherance of their common object, formed themselves into an unlawful assembly, due to previous enmity, wrongfully restrained the defacto complainant and his friend Abhinav, who were coming after Guruvayur Ekadasi, accused no.1 uttered obscene words and pulled his shirt. When the defacto complainant tried to run from the place, accused no.1 beat on his head with an iron pipe. When the defacto complainant evaded the same, it hit on the left side of his head and he sustained grievous injury. When Abhinav, the friend of defacto complainant tried to save the defacto complainant, accused no.2 kicked him and beat him with stick and accused nos. 3 to 5 caused hurt to them by beating and kicking them. If the defacto complainant had not evaded the attack of the accused no.1, it would have resulted in his death. Accused has thereby committed offences punishable under sections 189(2), 191(2), 190, 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 110, 351(2), 296(b) of BNS.

3. Accused were released on bail. On appearance of accused through counsel, copies of all relevant prosecution records were furnished to them.

4. The offences alleged against the accused are exclusively triable by the Hon'ble Court of Session. Hence, this case is committed to the Hon'ble Court of Session, Thrissur under section 232(a) of BNSS for trial.

5. Transmit the case records forthwith to the Hon'ble Court of Session and properties, if any, as and when required. Committal of the case shall be intimated to the Public Prosecutor, Thrissur. Accused are directed to appear before the Hon'ble Court of Session, Thrissur as and when so directed by the said Court.
