Sentence or Order :- The case against Nos 1 to 3 is committed to the Hon'ble Court of Sessions, Thrissur for trial.

ORDER

The accused is charge sheeted by the Sub Inspector of Police, Valappad police station in crime 971/25 alleging commission of offences punishable under sections 126(2),115(2),118(1),118(2),351(1),296(b),110 r/w Sec.3(5) of BNS .

2. The prosecution allegation, in brief, is as follows: Accused Nos. 1 and 2, due to enmity that at Mallus Makkani Hotel, Edamuttam, the shawarma ordered by them

was brought late, uttered obscene words to the brother-in-law of the de facto complainant and criminally intimidated him. When the de facto complainant and his friends intervened, the 1st accused criminally intimidated them by saying that they would set fire to the shop and hit on the face of the de facto complainant. When Rejil tried to prevent the accused, the 2nd accused twisted his hand, and the 3rd and 4th accused, uttering obscene words, voluntarily caused hurt to the de facto complainant and Rejil by hitting on various parts of their body. The 1st accused hit the defacto complainant with a granite stone on his head, which would have resulted in his death if not prevented. Thus, the accused persons committed the aforesaid offences in furtherance of their common intention.

3. Accused Nos 1 to 3 appeared before the court and they are on bail. The copies of all relevant prosecution records were furnished to the accused and thereby the requirements under section 230 of BNSS was complied with. Accused No.4 is absconding.

4. On perusal of available materials, it appeared to me that the offence alleged against the accused is exclusively triable by the Court of Sessions. Therefore, the case against the accused is hereby committed to Hon'ble Sessions Court, Thrissur under section 232(a) of BNSS.

5. The accused Nos.1 to 3 are directed to appear before Sessions Court as and when directed u/s.232(b) of BNSS.

6. The case records and properties shall be submitted under section 232(c) of BNSS before the Hon'ble Sessions Court when summoned.

7. The Public Prosecutor, Thrissur shall be notified regarding the committal of

the case u/s 232(d) of BNSS.

Accused No.4 is absconding. Hence, case against accused No.4 is split up and refiled as CP 56/26.
