ORDER

This petition is filed under sec.22(a) of Passport Act, 1967. The petitioner is the accused in the above case and he filed this petition for seeking permission to renew the passport.

2. Petitioner stands charged in Crime No.622/21 of Aloor Police Station alleging offence punishable under section 420 of Indian Penal Code.

3. Heard both sides.

4. The learned Assistant Public Prosecutor has no serious objection in allowing the petition. The petitioner has approached this court for seeking permission to renew the passport. The petitioner submit that his passport bearing number N3311632 was expired on 06.10.2025. I have perused the records. Petitioner is already on bail with sufficient sureties and charge was framed read over and explained to the accused to which he pleaded not guilty and claims to be tried. In the light of the above mentioned circumstances, I am of the considered view that the petition has to be allowed for a period of two years.

In the result, the petition is allowed and the Regional Passport Authority Cochin is hereby informed that this court places no objection for renewing passport to the petitioner for a period of two years, if he is otherwise eligible. However, it is made clear that he shall not go abroad without the prior permission of this court.
