ORDER

This case is instituted on a final report filed by the Inspector of Police Koratty in Crime 894/2025 of Koratty police station alleging offences punishable under sections u/Ss.126(2), 118(1) and 103(1) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita

2. The prosecution case in brief is that, on 09.9.2025 the deceased, Joy, and his son, the accused were drinking alcohol and having food at their house, the accused picked up a quarrel with Joy regarding the fact that his mother had left the house after a dispute. Thereafter, Joy went out of the house and later returned. When another quarrel broke out between them, at some time between 11:00 PM and 12:00 midnight, the accused allegedly took a knife and stabbed Joy on the left side of his neck, causing

a deep injury. As it has been revealed that Joy died as a result of the injury. Thus the accused committed the aforesaid offences.

3. On appearance of the accused before court, copies of all relevant prosecution records were furnished to the accused and thereby the requirements under Sec.230 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (In short "BNSS") was complied with. Accused is represented by a counsel of his own choice. He is on bail.

4. On perusal of available materials, it appears to me that the offence alleged against accused is exclusively triable by the Court of Sessions. Therefore, the case against accused is committed to Hon'ble Sessions Court, Thrissur for trial as provided under Sec. 232(a) of BNSS. The case records shall be forwarded to Hon'ble Sessions Court, the property produced if any shall be subject to rule 79(2) of BNSS.

5. Accused is directed to appear before the Hon'ble Sessions Court on summons u/s.232(b) of BNSS.

6. The case records and properties shall be submitted under Sec.232(c) of BNSS before the Hon'ble Sessions Court when summoned.

7. The Public Prosecutor, Thrissur shall be notified regarding the committal of the case under Sec. 232(d) of BNSS.
