ORDER

In this case, final report has been filed by Sub Inspector of Police, Kunnamkulam Police Station in Crime No.1198/2023 alleging commission of offences punishable under sections 341, 323, 324, 308, 294(b), 506(ii) r/w 34 of IPC.

2. The prosecution case in brief is that, The accused persons 1 to 4, due to prior enmity towards CW1 as he questioned the accused persons about their drugs business and gave complaint to police, on 17.08.2023 at 11.45 hours at Akkikkavu, in furtherance of their common intention to assault the defacto complainant wrongfully restrained him by stopping their car in front of his motor cycle and accused 2 opened the door of the car and hit the same on the motorcycle and as a result, he fell down and at that time accused 2 uttered obscene words to him and also beat him with hands and wooden stick. The first accused beat on the head of CW1 with an iron pipe and kicked him. The accused also threatened to kill CW1 if he gave complaint to police. The accused also destroyed the scooter, mobile phone, watch and spectacles of the CW1 and caused mischief to the tune of Rs.30,000/- to him. Thus the accused committed offences punishable under sections 341, 323, 324, 308, 294(b), 506(ii) read with 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. The accused 1 to 4 were granted bail and they executed the same before this Court. Copies of all the relevant prosecution records were furnished to them.

4. Upon perusal of the available materials, it appears to me that, the case of accused is triable exclusively by the Court of Sessions. Therefore, the case against the accused is hereby committed to the Honourable Court of Sessions, Thrissur, u/s 209 (a) of

Code of Criminal Procedure.

5. The records and properties, shall be submitted before the Honourable Court of Sessions, as and when called for u/s 209 (c) of Code of Criminal Procedure.

6. The Public Prosecutor, Thrissur shall be notified regarding the committal of the case u/s 209(d) of Code of Criminal Procedure.
