ORDER

The present case arose on a final report filed by the Sub Inspector of Police, Chelakkara Police Station in Crime No.46/2024 against the accused for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 323 of Indian Penal Code.

2. **Prosecution case in brief is as follows:** On 20.01.2024 at 10.00 PM while CW1 was walking with his brother and friend along the road near CPM Local Committee office, Pangarappilly, the accused came on a motorcycle, stopped CW1 and kicked him on the spine, causing him to fall into a drain. As a result, CW1 sustained a contusion to the right shoulder bone and swelling of the spine. Thus, the accused committed the offences punishable under Sections 341, 323 of Indian Penal Code.

3. The case was originally filed as CC:155/2024 before the Hon'ble Judicial First Class Magistrate, Wadakkanchery. The Hon'ble Court took cognizance of the offence, and on finding sufficient grounds for proceeding against the accused, issued process for appearance. Subsequently, as per order no. C3-23771/2025 dated 24.09.2025 of Hon'ble Sessions Judge, Thrissur, the above case was transferred to this Court and it was taken on file as CC:29/2024.

4. Upon issuance of summons, the accused appeared before this court on 09.01.2026,

and was enlarged on bail the same day. Copy of all relevant prosecution records was given to the accused, thus complying with s.230 of BNSS. Thereafter, his plea was recorded wherein he pleaded not guilty and claimed to be tried. Since it was submitted that the matter was settled, summons was issued to CW1.

5. At that stage, on perusing the prosecution records it was noted that CW1, who is the injured in this case, is only 17 years old. Since it was found that the offences alleged are committed against a minor, in view of Section 25 of the Commission for Protection of Child Rights Act, 2005 the case was converted to CP:05/2026. After perusing the prosecution records, I am satisfied that the offences alleged against the accused is exclusively triable by the Court of Sessions (Special Court) and hence, the case is committed to the Hon'ble Court of Sessions, Thrissur under Section 362 of BNSS.

6. The accused shall appear before the Hon'ble Court of Sessions, Thrissur as and when directed by the Hon'ble Court of Sessions, Thrissur.

7. The office is directed to send the entire records of this case to the Hon'ble Court of Sessions, Thrissur forthwith. Notify the commitment of the case to the learned Public prosecutor, Thrissur.
