Order : Case against the three accused are committed to the Hon'ble Sessions Court, Thrissur under Section 362 of BNSS

ORDER

The present case arose on a final report filed by the Sub Inspector of Police, Chelakkara Police Station in Crime No.526/2019 against the three accused for offences punishable under Section 341, 323 r/w 34 of Indian Penal Code.

2. **Prosecution case in brief is as follows:** The first accused is the brother of the complainant, the second accused is the wife of the first accused, and the third accused is the wife of another brother. On 23.12.2019 at about 11:00 am, due to animosity that the defacto complainant, her two sisters and niece went to see their mother in the ancestral house at Thottekkod, the second and third accused wrongfully restrained them. Then the first accused hit them with their hands, dragged them and threw them down, causing them injuries. Thus, the three accused committed the offences punishable under Sections 341, 323 r/w 34 of Indian Penal Code.

3. The case was originally filed as CC:8/2020 before this court and on finding sufficient grounds for proceeding against the three accused, process was issued for their appearance.

4. Upon issuance of process, all three accused eventually appeared before this court on 27.03.2024, and were enlarged on bail the same day. Copy of all relevant prosecution records was given to the accused, thus complying with s.230 of BNSS. Thereafter, their plea was recorded wherein all three accused pleaded not guilty and claimed to be tried. Then the case was posted for prosecution evidence.

5. At the stage of prosecution evidence, on perusing the prosecution records, it was noted that CW4 who is an injured person in this case, is only 14 years old at the time of the incident. Since it was found that the offences alleged are committed against a minor, in view of Section 25 of the Commission for Protection of Child Rights Act, 2005 the case was converted to CP:03/2026. After perusing the prosecution records, I am satisfied that the offences alleged against the accused are exclusively triable by the Court of Sessions (Special Court) and hence, the case is committed to the Hon'ble Court of Sessions, Thrissur under Section 362 of BNSS.

6. The three accused shall appear before the Hon'ble Court of Sessions, Thrissur as and when directed by the Hon'ble Court of Sessions, Thrissur.

7. The office is directed to send the entire records of this case to the Hon'ble Court of Sessions, Thrissur forthwith. Notify the commitment of the case to the learned Public prosecutor, Thrissur.
