This petition coming on this day for hearing, the court passed the following:

JUDGMENT

This is a joint petition filed by the husband and wife seeking dissolution of marriage by mutual consent under Section 10A of the Divorce Act.

2. The averments in this petition, in brief, are as follows:- The petitioners were married on 02.07.2023 at St. Lazars RC Church, Chavakkad as per the Christian religious rites and ceremonies and their marriage had been irretrievably broken down and they were living separately from 18.09.2024 onwards. No child was born in their wedlock. They are of the opinion that there is no possibility for reunion and they have agreed to get the marriage dissolved. There is no collusion in filing this petition. On the above pleadings, they pray for the dissolution of their marriage.

3. The joint petition was submitted before the court on 11.02.2026.

4. When the case came up for consideration today, I enquired once again and found that there is no change of opinion and that their marriage has been irretrievably broken down and they want dissolution of marriage. They filed affidavits in support of their petition. It is recorded. The enquiry conducted as per the decision of the Hon'ble High Court in **Tiji Daniel Vs.Roy Panamkoodan** reported in ILR 2018(4) Kerala 760. Both petitioners were examined through Video Conference as PW1 and PW2. Ext. A1 was marked. Ext. A1 is the copy of Certificate of Marriage.

5. From the evidence on record, the case of the petitioners stands proved.

In the result, this petition is allowed without costs. The marriage between the petitioners solemnized on 02.07.2023 will stand dissolved under Section 10A of the Divorce Act, from the date of this judgment.
