This MA(Arb) came up for hearing on 12.06.2026 and the Court on the same day passed the following:

ORDER

This is an application filed by the petitioner u/s 9 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act to direct the Advocate Commissioner to seize the petition schedule vehicle and hand it over to the petitioner.

2. Respondents entered appearance. Thereupon, the disputes were settled on the basis of an agreement. The agreement signed by the petitioner and 1st respondent is produced. Disputes have been amicably settled between the parties. I have perused the terms of settlement-agreement reduced into writing and signed by parties. It appears that terms are lawful in nature and hence they are accepted.

In the result, petition is allowed on terms as follows:-

1. After deducting Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One lakh) paid to the petitioner on 07.11.2025, 1st respondent shall pay Rs.35,000/- (Rupees thirty Five thousand Only) each on 28.11.2025, 28.12.2025 and 28.02.2026.
2. 1st respondent shall continue to pay EMI @ Rs.17,853/- from 28.02.2026 to 28.04.2027.
3. Settlement-agreement shall form part of the Order.
