Accused	:	Kiran @ Kaili Kiran, aged 27 years, S/o.Murukan, Kiran Bhavan, Mylakkara, Kuttiyanikkad (from Kannankara Colony Veedu, Kuttiyanikkadu Desom, Keezharoor Village). (By Adv.Smt. Rajeena R Maxipaul.)

Offence : Punishable U/ss.296(b), 132, 109, 351(3) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

Sentence or Order : The case against the accused is committed to the Hon'ble Sessions Court, Thiruvananthapuram, as provided u/s.232(b) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.

This case coming on this day, the Court passed the following:-

**ORDER**

The case arose from a Final Report filed by the Inspector Station House Officer, Aryancode Police Station in Crime No.883/2025, alleging that the accused committed offence punishable U/ss. 296(b), 132, 109, 351(3) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita.

2. The prosecution case is as follows:- On getting satisfied that the accused violated section 15(1)(b) of the KAA(P)A and reached his house within the limits of Aryancode Police Station, the police officials including CW16, who is the Station House Officer of the Police Station reached the spot on 27/11/2025 at 09.15 a.m., and then the accused with the necessary intention, at his house, Kiran Bhavan, Mylakkara in Keezharoor Village, refused to open the door of the house as demanded by the police officials. When the police officials

availed entry to the house by break opening its door, the accused uttered obscene words against them, and by using a machete equipped with him attempted to kill CW16 and the police officials who were on their duty. CW16 was thus forced to use his pistol in order to save his life as well as the life of his colleagues. The accused then ran out of his house and created a terrific atmosphere using the machete against the police officials who were standing at the premises of the house. Due to the acts of the accused, especially his act of attempt to murder against the police officials, they were prevented from exercising their official duty. The accused is thus alleged to have committed the aforementioned offences.

3. The accused is in judicial custody. Copies of all relevant prosecution records were served to the accused and thereby mandate u/s.230 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 was complied with.

4. After perusing the prosecution records and hearing both sides, it appears that the offences alleged against the accused is exclusively triable by the Hon'ble Court of Sessions and hence the case against the accused is committed to the Hon'ble Sessions Court, Thiruvananthapuram as provided u/s. 232(b) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.

5. The accused is directed to produce before the Hon'ble Sessions Court, Thiruvananthapuram, as and when required by the Hon'ble Sessions Court.

6. Transmit the case records and material objects to the Hon'ble Sessions Court as per Rules.

7. Notify the order of committal of the case to the Learned Public Prosecutor, concerned.
