Order : Petition is allowed

This CMP having been heard on this day, and the Court on the same day, passed the following:

ORDER

1. This is an application filed by the accused in CC 316/2020 (crime No.717/2019 of Kanjiramkulam Police Station) seeks for issuance of a police clearance certificate for getting a permanent job in government as a driver.
2. The application averments in brief is that petitioner is the accused in CC.316/2020. The petitioner / accused is working as a M Panel driver in KSRTC. Now he has a chance to got a permanent job as a driver in government service. Hence a police clearance certificate is highly necessary for him to produce before the government.
3. He had given an application before Kanjiramkulam police but the same

is rejected by the police authorities stating that they cannot issue police clearance certificate without an order from the concerned court. If the application is not allowed, he may not be able to get a job as a driver in government service. Therefore the applicant is entitled to apply for the police clearance certificate only if the permission is granted by this court. The petitioner/ accused undertakes that he is ready to abide any condition imposed by this court and shall appear before the court as and when required. Hence this application.

4. Prosecution filed report stating that this case is pending before this court. Hence there is difficulty in issuing police clearance certificate.
5. Heard both sides.
6. On perusal of the prosecution records it is seen that the applicant is the accused in Kanjiramkulam Police Station Crime No. 717/2019 which was taken on file as CC 316/2020 alleging offences punishable u/ss. 323 and 498(A) of IPC and sec. 3(1) of Protection of Women from Domestic violence Act. The applicant is on bail in this case. The applicant herein sought for police clearance certificate from the Kanjiramkulam Police in order to get a permanent job in government service. Issuance of police clearance certificate is a miscellaneous service provided by police department. The applicant is entitled for police clearance certificate only if there is no adverse information which would render him ineligible. There is no dispute in the fact that the pendency of a criminal case is not a reason which would render a person ineligible for police clearance certificate. Learned APP also has

no serious objection in granting the application.

7. Considering the job of the applicant and the present stage of pending case before this court, I am inclined to allow this application for issuing police clearance certificate on following conditions:

1. The petitioner / accused shall appear before this court as and when directed by this Court.
2. The petitioner shall produce self attested copy of the job details before this court.
3. The Station House Officer of Kanjiramkulam Police is hereby directed to issue the No Objection Certificate to the petitioner/ accused upon production of this order, if he is not otherwise disqualified and also in accordance with law.

Hence, the CMP is allowed.
