Accused	:	Kanakaraj, Aged 48/24, S/o Nesamani, Thachanvilai Veedu, Door No.7/1A, Methummal Village, Killiyoor, Kanyakumari District. Represented by Adv. T.Rajaraja Singh
Offences	:	U/s. 447, 294(b), 323, 324, 506(i) and 308 IPC.
Finding	:	Triable by Hon'ble Court of Sessions.
Sentence/Order	:	Case against the accused is committed to the Hon'ble Sessions Court, Thiruvananthapuram, u/s.232 BNSS.

This case has been heard today, and the court passed the following:

ORDER

1. Final Report in this case was filed the Sub Inspector of Police, Kanjiramkulam police station in crime No. 488/2023, alleging offences punishable u/s.447, 294(b), 323, 324, 506(i) and 308 IPC.
2. The prosecution case is that due to prior enmity, with the intention to utter obscene words, threaten, inflict bodily hurt and to commit culpable homicide, on 17.04.2023 at 10.45 pm, the accused trespassed into the courtyard of the house of CW1 at Nampyathi junction in Kanjiramkulam village, called him out, uttered obscene words, threatened to kill him, beaten on his head with an iron rod kept with him and inflicted injury and when he evaded, the blow inflicted injury above his right eyebrow. If CW1 would not have prevented the blow on

his head, it would have resulted in deep injury and would have resulted in his death. Thus the accused was alleged to have committed the offences U/s. 447, 294(b), 323, 324, 506(i) and 308 IPC.

3. The accused was granted bail and was defended by a counsel of his choice. Copies of all records relied on by the prosecution are served to the accused. The copies are found to be in order. S.230 of BNSS is therefore duly complied with. The accused was also served with the list as contemplated under Rule 19(4) CRP.
4. Since the offence u/s. 308 of IPC is exclusively triable by a Court of Sessions, the case against accused is committed to the Hon'ble Sessions Court, Thiruvananthapuram for trial as per section 232 BNSS.
5. The accused is directed to appear before the Hon'ble Sessions Court as and when required.
6. Transmit the case records and material objects to the Hon'ble Sessions Court as per rule 77(1) of the Criminal Rule of Practice, Kerala.
7. Notify the order of committal to the learned Public Prosecutor.
