Interim order is allowed.

ORDER

1. This is the petition filed by the petitioner u/s.23 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act for interim order.
2. Having gone through the petition and affidavit of the 1st petitioner, prima facie case in favour of the petitioners are indicated. Hence, I am of the view that the

delay that may be caused for serving notice to the respondent may defeat the purpose of the petition and hence ad-interim exparte order can be given in favour of the petitioners, since the prima facie in her favour has been indicated in the affidavit filed by her.

3. In the result, petition is allowed in part and following ad-interim order passed u/s. 23 of Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005.

- a) The respondent is hereby restrained from committing any act of domestic violence against the petitioners, ie, mental, physical, verbal, emotional and economic abuse.
- b) The respondent is further restrained from forcefully evicting the petitioners from the house, Gouriganga Bhavan, Paruthimadom Lane, Mudavoorpara, Balaramapuram.P.O.

Issue notice and copy of this order to the respondent by registered post if petitioner take steps and forward copy of the order to Station House Officer, Balaramapuram for favour of information and necessary action.

Comply with S.24 of the Act also.
