This case has been heard today, and the court passed the following:

ORDER

1. Final Report in this case was filed by the Excise Inspector of Amaravila Excise Range Excise in crime No. 80/2025, alleging offences punishable U/s. 8(1), 8(2) and 55(g) of Abkari Act.

2. The prosecution case is that 26.08.2025, at 01.30 pm, at the kitchen of the house of the accused near Subhananda Ashram in Anavoor village, the Preventive Officer of Amaravila Excise Range and party found the accused engaged in manufacturing arrack and was also found in possession of

15 litres of arrack, 120 litres of wash and other basic implements for manufacturing arrack, in contravention of the provisions of Abkari Act. Thus the accused has committed offences punishable U/s. 8(1), 8(2) and 55(g) of Abkari Act.

3. The accused was granted bail and was defended by counsel of his choice. Copies of all records relied on by the prosecution are served to the accused. The copies are found to be in order. S.230 BNSS and R 19(4) of CRP are therefore duly complied with.

4. Since the offence U/s.8(1), 8(2) and 55(g) of Abkari Act is exclusively triable by a Court of Sessions, the case is committed to the Hon'ble Sessions Court, Thiruvananthapuram for trial as per section 232 of BNSS.

5. The accused is directed to appear before the Hon'ble Sessions Court as and when required.

6. Transmit the case records and material objects to the Hon'ble Sessions Court as per rule 77(2) of the Criminal Rule of Practice, Kerala. Chemical Report is also enclosed herewith.

7. Notify the order of committal to the learned Public Prosecutor.
