Sentence or Order : Accused is sentenced to pay fine of Rs 250/- for offences u/s. 281 BNS, in default of payment of fine, accused shall undergo simple imprisonment for 2 days.

J U D G M E N T

1. Accused stands charge sheeted by the Sub Inspector of Police, Marayamuttam.  
in Crime No. 1195/25... alleging offence punishable u/s. 281 BNS. 146. 196. MV ACT

2. Accused present. Copy of relevant prosecution records were given to accused. Particulars of offence was read over and explained to the accused to which he pleaded guilty. Accused is cautioned about the penal consequences. Despite the same he pleaded guilty. Hence accused is found guilty u/s. 281 BNS and convicted him thereunder.

3. Considering the nature of the offences, I am of opinion that this is not a fit case to apply the benevolent provisions of Probation of Offenders Act.

4. I am of the opinion that the sentence awarded below will meet the ends of justice.

5. Accused is sentenced to pay fine of Rs 250/- for offences u/s. 281 BNS, in default of payment of fine, accused shall undergo simple imprisonment for 2 days.
