Sentence/Order	Case against the accused persons 1 to 3 are committed to the Hon'ble Court of Sessions, Thiruvananthapuram as provided u/S. 232 (a) of the BNSS.

This case has been finally heard on 25.03.2026, the court passed the following:

ORDER

Final report was filed by the Sub Inspector of Police, Aryanad Police Station in Crime No. 813/2025 alleging commission of offences punishable u/Ss. 296(b), 115(2), 118(1), 85 & 110 of the BNS.

2. The prosecution case is, in brief, is as follows:-

On 15.06.2025 at about 7:00 p.m., at Minankal Junction in Aryanad Village, due to enmity of accused persons 1 to 3 against CW1 for warning them against uttering obscene words in public, the 1st accused infurtherance of their cmmon intention with the other accused attacked CW1 with a sword-like weapon aiming at his neck, which CW1 warded off with his left hand, sustaining a deep cut injury and fracture near the wrist,

along with nerve and tendon damage. At the same time, accused Nos. 2 and 3 assaulted CW1 by punching him on the abdomen. Had the blow landed on the neck of CW1, it could have resulted in his death. Thus, accused Nos. 1 to 3, are alleged to have committed the aforesaid offences.

3. After taking cognizance of the offence, the case was proceeded as CP 129/2025. Summons was issued to the accused persons 1 to 3 pursuant to which they appeared before the Court. Accused persons 1 to 3 were enlarged on bail. They were represented by a counsel of their own choice. Copies of all relevant prosecution records were furnished to the accused in compliance with Section 230 of the BNSS 2023.

4. After perusing the prosecution records and hearing both sides, it appears that the offences alleged against the accused are exclusively triable by the Hon'ble Court of Sessions and hence the case against the accused are committed to the Hon'ble Court of Sessions, Thiruvananthapuram, as provided u/s. 232(a) of the BNSS.

5. The accused persons 1 to 3 are directed to appear before the Hon'ble Court of Sessions, Thiruvananthapuram, as and when required by the Hon'ble Court of Sessions.

6. The entire records and material objects, if any, shall be forwarded to the Hon'ble Court of Sessions forthwith under section 232(c) of the BNSS.

7. The Public Prosecutor, shall be notified of the committal of the case under section 232(d) of the BNSS.
