This case has been finally heard on 19.03.2026, the court passed the following:

ORDER

Final report was filed by the Sub Inspector of Police, Venjaramoodu Police Station in Crime No. 1598/2025 alleging commission of offences punishable u/Ss. 333, 296(b), 115(2), 351(2), 74 & 77 of the BNS.

2. The prosecution case is, in brief, is as follows:-

The accused was on friendly terms with CW1's family and frequently visited their house. During these visits, he took private photographs of CW1 on his mobile phone without her knowledge. He later expressed romantic interest in her and repeatedly contacted her, which she refused and informed her husband. Due to this resentment, on 04.11.2025 at about 8:30 p.m., the accused trespassed into her house armed with a chopper, intending to cause harm. He abused CW1 using obscene language, caught hold of her hair, and threatened to kill her. He also threatened to morph and circulate her private photographs. Thereafter, the accused assaulted CW1 and her children, causing mental distress and

thereby outraging the modesty of CW1. Thus, the accused is alleged to have committed the aforesaid offences.

3. After taking cognizance of the offence, the case was proceeded as CP 10/2026. Summons was issued to the accused pursuant to which he appeared before the Court. Accused was enlarged on bail. He was represented by a counsel of his own choice. Copies of all relevant prosecution records were furnished to the accused in compliance with Section 230 of the BNSS 2023.

4. After perusing the prosecution records and hearing both sides, it appears that the offences alleged against the accused is exclusively triable by the Hon'ble Court of Sessions and hence the case against the accused are committed to the Hon'ble Court of Sessions, Thiruvananthapuram, as provided u/s. 232(a) of the BNSS.

5. The accused is directed to appear before the Hon'ble Court of Sessions, Thiruvananthapuram, as and when required by the Hon'ble Court of Sessions.

6. The entire records and material objects, if any, shall be forwarded to the Hon'ble Court of Sessions forthwith under section 232(c) of the BNSS.

7. The Public Prosecutor, shall be notified of the committal of the case under section 232(d) of the BNSS.
