ORDER

This is a petition filed u/s. 12 of the Protection of woman from domestic Violence Act, 2005(hereinafter referred as PWDV Act).

2.The crux of the case averred by the petitioner/respondent no.1 is that the first petitioner is the legally wedded wife of the respondent. The second petitioner is the child born out of the said wedlock. This petition is filed by the counsel for the petitioners seeking interim maintenance of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand only). Hence, the petition.

3.Copy of the C.M.P. served. To which learned counsel for the respondent submitted that he is ready to pay the amount. But that some time may be granted.

4.Heard both sides.

5. The learned counsel for the respondent has not raised any serious objection to the CMP, but only sought time for payment. The petitioners have produced relevant records which would convince this Court that the claim of the petitioners is genuine. Hence, the CMP is allowed, and the respondent is directed to pay an amount of Rs.20,000/- as interim maintenance to the petitioner and child on or before 05.06.2026.
