Accused	:	Muhammed Abeen, S/o Muhammed Iqbal, Rasiya cotege, Kalankavu, Peppara, Vithura. (By Adv. Sri. Vishnu Kumar. A)
Charge	:	Offences punishable u/ss. 269 IPC, 118 (e) of KP Act and sec. 4(2) (d) r/w 5 of Kerala Epidemic Diseases Ordinance 2020.
Plea	:	Guilty
Finding	:	Guilty.
Sentence or order	:	Accused is sentenced to pay fine of ₹. 250/- and sec. 4(2) (d) r/w 5 of Kerala Epidemic Diseases Ordinance 2020. In default of payment of fine accused person directed to undergo simple imprisonment for 30 days.

This case coming on for today's proceedings, the court passed the following :-

JUDGMENT

This case arose on a final report filed by the Sub Inspector of police, Vithura against the accused for the offence punishable u/s. 4(2) (d) r/w 5 of Kerala Epidemic Diseases Ordinance 2020.

Accused represented through counsel. Accused person plead guilty through counsel.

Particular of offences u/s sec. 4(2) (d) r/w 5 of Kerala Epidemic Diseases Ordinance 2020 and read over and explained to the accused person through counsel and he pleaded guilty through counsel. Since the plea was voluntarily the same was accepted. The accused person is found guilty of the offence punishable U/S 4(2) (d) r/w 5 of Kerala Epidemic Diseases Ordinance 2020 and convicted thereunder. Offence u/s. 269 IPC and 118 (e) KP Act deleted u/s 71 of IPC.

I am of the opinion that a sentence of fine will meet the ends of justice. Being so sentence of fine alone would be sufficient and accused is sentenced to pay fine of ₹. 250/- 4(2) (d) r/w 5 of Kerala Epidemic Diseases Ordinance 2020. In default of payment of fine accused person is directed to undergo simple imprisonment for 30 days.
