The Original petition have been finally heard on 29/04/2026 and the Tribunal passed the following:-

AWARD

This petition is u/S.166(1) &140 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 seeking compensation on account of the injuries sustained by the petitioner in a motor vehicle accident. The 1st respondent is the owner cum driver and the 2nd respondent is the insurer of the vehicle involved in the accident.

Notices were served to the respondents for their appearance.

Subsequently during the course of proceedings, the petitioner and the respondent No.2 have arrived at an out of court settlement and filed a Joint Memo before this Tribunal that the matter was settled for **Rs.2,40,000/- (Rupees Two Lakh Forty Thousand Only)** towards full satisfaction of the claim and the respondent No.2 has agreed to pay that amount. The parties sought for an award in terms of that compromise. The Joint Memo dated 23/04/2026 is accepted.

In the result, this Petition is allowed and the award is passed as follows:-

- (1) The 2nd respondent is directed to pay a total amount of **Rs.2,40,000/- (Rupees Two Lakh Forty Thousand Only)** to the petitioner towards compensation.
- (2) The 2nd respondent is directed to deposit the awarded sum directly to the credit of the Savings Bank Account of **Smt.Sujatha.T.S., A/c No175312301203763 of Kerala State Co-Operative Bank Ltd, Mayyil Branch with IFSC: KSBK001753** as per the details furnished by the petitioner and send a copy of that payment advice to this Tribunal and also serve a copy of the same to petitioner or to her counsel, as required by Hon'ble High Court in its Circular No.01/2025 dated 19/09/2025.
- (3) The Joint Memo shall also form part of this award.
- (4) Parties shall bear their respective costs.
