

CASE CALLED BEFORE LOK ADALATH

DATED 12-11-2022.

Accused present.

The accused voluntarily submits to plead guilty of the offence against him/her.

Case papers furnished to the accused person as required under section 207 of Cr.P.C.

The Adalath has warned the accused that if he/she pleads guilty, he /she may have to pay fine.

In spite of the same, the accused proceeded to plead guilty. The gist of accusation for the offence punishable under section 144(1) of Railways Act is recorded in the form of plea. The same is read over and explained to him/her. He/she pleads guilty. The plea of guilty by the accused found voluntary. Hence, the Adalath proceeds to pass following.

ORDER

Acting under section 241 of Cr.P.C accused is convicted for the offence punishable under section 144(1) of Railways Act.

Since the accused has pleaded guilty before Lok Adalath and has this a first time offence, lenient view is taken and accused is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs. 300/- In default to pay fine, he/she shall undergo S.I for 1 day.
