

State Vs. Munish

Present:- Sh.Sachin Singh Kataria, Ld. APP for the State.
Accused Munish is in custody represented by Legal Aid Counsel.

Accused Munish produced before me in custody.

Application for police remand of five days of accused Munish sought. Case diary seen, signed, & returned. As per the disclosure statement of the accused, the place of the occurrence has to be identified by the accused and his police custody is required for recovery of mobile phone VIVO, Laptop Lenovo and cash Rs.2,000- used in the offence at the instance of accused from Pilibhit (Uttar Pradesh), as per the disclosure statement. Therefore, in order to facilitate the proper course of investigation, the police custody of the accused Munish is granted till date i.e. **10.08.2026**. The accused Munish be produced before this court on the date fixed i.e. **10.08.2026**.

I.O. is directed to get the accused medically examined every 12 hours during proceedings of police remand. In case the accused refuses to affect the recovery or demarcation and there is no further need for police custody, the I.O. shall produce the accused before the Court at the earliest and shall also furnish a written explanation as to the reasons for the refusal at this stage after the initial recording of statements before the investigating agency.

Application regarding appointment of Legal Aid Counsel has been filed by accused Munish. Same be forwarded to Ld. CJM-cum-Secretary, DLSA, Jhajjar for information and necessary action.
