State Vs. Jaswinder Singh alias Munshi

Present: Sh. Prabhdeep Singh, Advocate counsel for applicant/accused.
APP for the State.

Heard on bail application filed by applicant/accused Jaswinder Singh alias Munshi son of Balwant Singh. It is averred that applicant/accused is in judicial custody since 25.06.2024 and is no more required by the police for further investigation. Case against the applicant/accused is false and fabricated. Name of the applicant/accused is not mentioned in the FIR. It is further averred that there is no likelihood of the applicant/accused to abscond nor he will temper the prosecution evidence if admitted on bail. False case FIR No.148/2022, under section 295-A IPC etc, P.S. Sadar Patti and FIR No.71/2024, under section 25 Arms Act, 1959, P.S. Chatiwind are pending against the applicant/accused. Prayer is made to allow the application.

On the other hand, learned APP for the State has opposed the present bail application on the ground that there are serious allegations against the accused/applicant and there is possibility of tempering of evidence by the accused /applicant in case he is released on bail. Therefore, learned APP for the State has prayed that present bail application be dismissed.

After hearing Learned counsel for the applicant/accused as well as Learned APP for the State, and perusal of the record shows that FIR in present case

was registered against unknown persons with allegations that they had given call to complainant to extort money of Rs.20 lakhs from him by putting him in fear and they even came on motorcycle pm the date of occurrence out side shop of complainant and raised two fires to put complainant in fear for about said purpose. Present applicant/accused was nominated in present case on the basis of supplementary statement of complainant. Accused is in judicial custody from 14.06.2024. Allegations levelled against accused are serious in nature. Investigation is still pending in present case. This court is not inclined to take lenient view in the present application. So present bail application is dismissed. Papers be attached with remand papers fixed for 23.07.2024.
