ORDER

1. This order shall dispose of two bail applications under section 482 of BNSS i.e. one filed by applicants-accused Baljit Singh and Nishan Singh and the second filed by applicant-accused Gurjit Singh in the above

noted FIR(Cross version).

2. The main FIR was registered on the basis of statement of Baljit Singh son of Malook Singh, resident of village Mandiala on the allegations that on 29.10.2025 at about 9.45 PM., he was present in the bazar and in the meantime, Mandeep Singh @ Mannu son of Baljit Singh came there on his motorcycle, who was carrying a rifle. He got down from the motorcycle and started hurling abuses and he uttered derogatory remarks against his caste (Kutia Churia) and then he fired a shot from the rifle towards him with an intention to kill him, but it missed the target and then they both grappled with each other. Assailant fled away from there after leaving his rifle there. On the basis of the said statement, FIR was registered.

The cross version in the present case was registered vide repat no. 13 dated 27.11.2025, on the basis of statement of Baljit Singh son of Swaran Singh, resident of village Mandiala PS Chattiwind on the allegations that on 29.10.2025 at about 9.45PM, he had watered the land taken on lease from Panchayat and due to darkness, he had called upon his son Mandeep Singh to bring .12 bore rifle for safety. Accordingly, his son Mandeep Singh and grandson Ekamjot aged about 12 years came there on a motorcycle. When his son was about to start motorcycle after handing over to him .12 bore rifle, in the meantime, Baljit Singh son of Malook Singh armed with baseball bat, Shubhpreet Singh @ Shubh armed with pistol, Nishan Singh armed with sota, Gurjit Singh @ Saga armed with dang along with 4-5 unidentified persons

having weapons came there. Baljit Singh raised a lalkara to teach them lesson for watering from Govt. motor and then, Gurjit Singh alias Saga gave a dang blow upon him, which hit on his left wrist. Thereafter, Baljit Singh gave baseball bat which hit on his left ribs. On raising hue and cry, all the assailants fled away from the spot and they also took away his rifle and cartridges and while leaving the spot, they also fired from his rifle. They also damaged his Electric Activa. On the basis of said statement, FIR in the present case was registered against the said persons.

2. Notice of the bail application was given to the State. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor appeared on behalf of the State and contested the same for the State.

3. This court has heard the contentions raised by learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State, learned counsel for applicants-accused and gone through the case file.

4. As per allegations, 'lalkara' is attributed to applicant/accused Baljit Singh. Besides, grievous injury with baseball bat i.e on the ribs of complainant/injured Baljit Singh, falling under Section 117(2) BNS is also attributed to applicant/accused Baljit Singh. However, no injury is attributed to accused-applicant Nishan Singh, though he was allegedly armed with 'sota'. Injury No.2 on left hand wrist of complainant is attributed to accused-applicant Gurjit Singh and as per medical record, the same has been declared simple in nature. Even otherwise, this is a version and cross version case. So, considering all the facts and allegations levelled against the accused-applicants as well as injuries

attributed to them, and since the applicants are ready to join the investigation and cooperate with the investigating agency, the applicants are directed to join the investigation within 03 days and it is also clarified that in the event of arrest, the applicants shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The copy of this Order be placed on record bail application No. 1382 of 2026 titled as “Gurjit Singh vs State”
