**COMMITTAL ORDER**

The case is charge sheeted by the Sub Inspector of Police, Attingal Police Station in Crime No. 42/2026, alleging commission of offences punishable U/ss. 110, 118(1), 296(b) & 351(2) of BNS.

2. The case of prosecution is that, accused out of the animosity towards the complainant in supporting the neighbours of the accused who gave complaint petition before Police against the accused, on 09/01/26 at about 07.30 pm, the accused uttered obscene words towards the complainant who was standing along with CW2 at the property of one Prithviraj, 1 km away from Thachoorkunnu junction and hit the complainant on his head using a wooden stick, voluntarily causing hurt, pushed him down, and again attempted to hit on the head of complainant which was thwarted by CW2 through his intervention. The accused did the above act with the knowledge that if death be caused by his act he would be guilty of culpable homicide not amounting to murder, thereby the accused committed the offences punishable under sections 110,

118(1), 296(b) & 351(2) of BNS, it is alleged.

3. Accused entered appearance on summons, he was enlarged on bail and copies of all relevant prosecution records were furnished to them under section 230 BNSS.

4. This court have perused the entire prosecution records. The offences alleged to have been committed by the accused are exclusively triable by the Court of Sessions. Hence, case against accused is committed to the Hon'ble Sessions Court, Thiruvananthapuram U/s. 232 BNSS on following conditions.

(1) The accused are directed to appear before the Hon'ble Court of Sessions, Thiruvananthapuram, on receipt of summons.

(2) The documents and properties will be submitted to the Hon'ble Court of Sessions, Thiruvananthapuram.

(3) The committal of the case shall be notified to the Public Prosecutor.
