- A3** : Biju aged 48 years S/o Soman, Kochuthitta Veedu, Near Kochuthitta Temple, Kadakkavoor Desom, Kadakkavoor Village.
- A4** : Shabeer aged 39 years S/o Basheer, Vadayil Veedu, Meerankadavu, Anchuthengu Desom, Anchuthengu Village.

- Offence : Punishable U/ss. 126(2), 296(b), 115(2), 118(1), 110 and 324(4) r/w Sec. 3(5) of the B.N.S, 2023.
- Order : Case against Accused Nos. 1, 3 and 4 are committed to Hon'ble Sessions Court, Thiruvananthapuram. Accused No. 2 is no more. Hence charge against Accused No. 2 stand abated.

This case coming on to this day's proceedings, the court passed the following:-

COMMITTAL ORDER

1. This is a case charge sheeted by the Sub Inspector of Police, Kadakkavoor Police Station, in Crime No. 648/2025 for the offences punishable U/ss. 126(2), 296(b), 115(2), 118(1), 110 and 324(4) r/w Sec. 3(5) of the B.N.S, 2023.
2. **The Prosecution allegation in brief are as follows** :- Due to prior vengeance towards informant, in furtherance of their common intention, 1st to 4th accused wrongfully restrained informant near Gas Godown, Kochuthitta, Kadakkavoor Desom in Kadakkavoor Village at 08.30 PM on 10/05/2025. The first accused uttered obscene words so as to cause annoyance to informant. The first accused hit and kicked the informant on his face and all over his body. Second to fourth accused held the informant and the 1st accused took a knife and slashed the informant on his head causing injuries. The informant lost his gold ring and Rs. 15,000/- and thereby suffered a loss of Rs. 40,000/- Thus, the accused have allegedly committed offences punishable u/ss. 126(2), 296(b), 115(2), 118(1), 110 and 324(4) r/w Sec. 3(5) of the B.N.S, 2023.
3. Accused Nos. 1, 3 and 4 appeared before court on summons and they were enlarged on bail. Copies of all relevant prosecution records were furnished to them under Section 207 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973. Accused No. 2 is no more. Hence charge against Accused No. 2 stand abated.
4. On verifying the records, it is seen that the offence under Sec.110 of B. N. S, 2023 is exclusively triable by the Honourable Court of Sessions. Hence, the case against the Accused Nos. 1, 3 and 4 is committed to Honourable Court of Sessions, Thiruvananthapuram, as per Section 232(a) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
5. The entire case records and material objects, if any involved in the case shall be

forwarded to the Honourable Court of Sessions forthwith as per Sec.232(c) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023. Accused Nos. 1, 3 and 4 shall appear before the Honourable Court of Sessions on getting summons/warrants.

6. Notify the committal of the case to the learned Public Prosecutor as contemplated under Section 232(d) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
