- Order : Case against Accused is committed to Hon'ble Children's Court, Thiruvananthapuram.

This case coming on to this day's proceedings, the court passed the following:-

**COMMITTAL ORDER**

1. This is a case charge sheeted by the Sub Inspector of Police, Kadakkavoor (in Crime No. 1270/2025 of Kadakkavoor Police Station) for the offences punishable under sections 296(b), 118(1) and 351(2), of the B.N.S, 2023, Sec. 75 of Juvenile Justice ( Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015 and Sec. 31(1) of Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005.
2. **The Prosecution allegation in brief are as follows** :- The informant obtained a Protection Order against her husband who is the accused herein from the Judicial First Class Magistrate -IV Court, Attingal vide CMP No. 4338/2025. Violating the said order, the accused uttered obscene words and threatened the informant so as to cause annoyance to her at 09.30 AM on 03/10/2025 at Manamboor Market. The accused hit and injured the informant with his Scooter

bearing no. KL 16 T 4224 and tried to injure informant's son. Thus, the accused has allegedly committed offences punishable u/ss. 296(b), 118(1) and 351(2), of the B.N.S, 2023, Sec. 75 of Juvenile Justice ( Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015 and Sec. 31(1) of Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005.

3. As per the amendment in the year 2021 and the consequential induction of subsection (4) in Sec.86 of the Juvenile Justice Act 2015, all the offences under the act shall be triable by the Children's Court. In these circumstances this case has to be tried by the Hon'ble Children's court.
4. Accused already entered appearance and he was enlarged on bail. The copies of all relevant prosecution records were furnished to him under Section 207 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
5. On verifying the case records, it is seen that the offence under Sec.75 of juvenile Justice Act, 2015 is also alleged against the accused. Hence, the case against the accused is committed to Honourable Children's Court, Thiruvananthapuram,
6. The entire case records and material objects, if any involved in the case shall be forwarded to the Honourable Children's Court Thiruvananthapuram forthwith. Accused shall appear before the Honourable Children's Court on getting summons/warrants.
7. Notify the committal of the case to the learned Public Prosecutor concerned.
