- Order : Case against accused is committed to Hon'ble Sessions Court, Thiruvananthapuram.

This case coming on to this day's proceedings, the court passed the following:-

**COMMITTAL ORDER**

1. This is a case charge sheeted by the Excise Range Inspector, Excise Range Office, Chirayinkeezhu in Crime No. 16/2025 for the offence punishable under section 55(i) of the Kerala Abkari Act, I of 1077.
2. **The Prosecution allegation in brief are as follows** :- At or about 02.00 PM on 01/02/2025, at Kayikkara Desom in Anchuthengu Village, Chirayinkeezhu Taluk the accused was found in possession of 10.5 liters of Indian Made Foreign Liquor for the purpose of sale without having any licence or any other documents, in contravention of the provision of the Abkari Act 1077. At the time of arrest, the excise officials recovered sale proceeds of ₹1,500/- from the possession of accused. Thus, the accused has committed the offences punishable u/s.55(i) of the Kerala Abkari Act, 1077.

3. Accused entered appearance and he was enlarged on bail. Copies of all relevant prosecution records were furnished to him under Section 230 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
4. On verifying records, it is seen that the offence under Section 55(i) of the Kerala Abkari Act, I of 1077 is exclusively triable by the Honourable Court of Session. Hence, the case against the accused is committed to Honourable Court of Session, Thiruvananthapuram, as per Section 232(a) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
5. The entire case records and material objects, if any involved in the case shall be forwarded to the Honourable Court of Session forthwith as per Sec.232(c) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023. Accused shall appear before the Honourable Court of Session on getting summons/warrants.
6. Notify the committal of the case to the learned Public Prosecutor as contemplated under Section 232(d) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
