ORDER

1. Vide this order, I shall dispose of application for bail, particulars of which are giving herein above, preferred under Section 483 of the B.N.S.S. Act, by aforesaid accused/applicant.
2. The brief facts of the case are that SI Mangal Singh alongwith other police party was present at main chowk, Baghapurana in connection with patrolling and checking of suspected persons, where he received secret information that Satnam Singh son of Bhag Singh is running a Golden Spa center in front of grain market, Kotkapura Road, Baghapurana and inside the room of said Spa center, he runs a flesh trade business after getting huge amount from the customers and he also brings women from outside to supply to customers for prostitution. If raid be conducted, several men and women involved in flesh trade business inside the rooms of Golden Spa Center can be apprehended. After finding the information reliable, ruqa was sent and accordingly, FIR was registered against the accused. Thereafter,

raid was conducted and the accused/applicant was apprehended on 09.04.2026 and since then he is in custody. Thus, accused-applicant has filed the present bail application.

3. I have heard learned counsel for applicant-accused as well as learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State and have gone through the record.

4. Perusal of file also reveals that allegations against accused-applicant are that accused/applicant was apprehended by the police on the basis of secret information who was indulged in immoral trafficking in said his Spa Center. Now, nothing is to be recovered from the accused/applicant. The culpability of the accused shall be gauged during trial. Accused/applicant is in custody since 09.05.2026. As such, keeping in view of the facts and circumstances of the present case and the fact that accused is in custody since the date of arrest and it will take considerable time for conclusion of trial. I am of the view that in given circumstances, no useful purpose is going to be served by keeping the accused/applicant in custody for longer period. As such, the accused/applicant is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing her bail bonds and surety bonds to the tune of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of learned Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate subject to the following conditions:

1. That the applicant will not tamper with the prosecution evidence.
2. That the applicant will appear before the Court on each and every date of hearing.
3. That the applicant will not leave country without prior permission of court.

5. It is further made clear that in case of any violation thereof, this order shall cease to have effect qua the same. File be consigned to the Record Room.
