State Vs Balwinder Singh

Reply by prosecution to the bail application not filed but Ld APP for the State has strongly opposed the bail application. As per allegations being levelled against the accused, accused has committed offence under section 61/1/14 Excise Act. Accused is already in judicial custody since 30.06.2019. Presentation of the challan would certainly take considerable time. Moreover modern law of jurisprudence leans towards granting bail than jail. If the accused is kept behind the bars then it would be burden on state exchequer. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances and in the interest of justice, present bail application is allowed to the effect that accused is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing his bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- with one surety in the like amount. Bail bonds and surety bonds not furnished. The application stands disposed of accordingly.
