O R D E R

This is a proceedings initiated under section 446
of the Code of Criminal Procedure, against the counter petitioners.

2. Counter petitioners herein are the sureties of the accused in ST 122/2023. Accused was absconded. Though, notices were issued to the counter petitioners, accused was not produced. Hence bail bond of the accused was cancelled and this Miscellaneous case was registered against the counter petitioners.

3. Thereupon, notices were issued to the counter petitioners as to why bond amount should not be realized from them. The counter petitioners did not appear inspite of service of notices. They have not shown sufficient cause for not imposing penalty. Hence, I am satisfied that the counter petitioners have no explanation to offer.

4. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, I am of the opinion that an amount of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees ten thousand only)each is imposed as penalty would meet the ends of justice.

5. In the result, the counter petitioners are directed to pay penalty of Rs. Rs.10,000/-(Rupees ten thousand only)each Penalty amount shall be realized as if imposed as fine by invoking section 461 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
