O R D E R

1. This is a petition seeking permission of this Court to renew the passport of the petitioner for a period of one year.

2. **Case of the petitioner in brief** :- Petitioner is the accused in this case and the offences alleged against him are punishable u/s 419, 468 and 420 r/w 34 of Indian Penal Code. According to the petitioner the court was pleased to permit the accused to renew his passport vide order in CMP 170/2022 dated

10/08/2022 and accordingly he has deposited Rs.10,000/- before the Court on 15/05/2024 and further permitted him to renew his passport for one year vide CMP 163/2025 dated 21/01/2025. The petitioner's son has got admission at Malaysia for Engineering programme and he is intending to visit his son at Malaysia. It is necessary to produce one year valid passport for the issuance of visa. Now the petitioner seeks the permission of the Court for the renewal of the passport for validity for a period of one year. Hence this petition.

3. The respondent filed report stating that if the permission is granted to the petitioner to go abroad there is possibility for him to influence the witness and the trial will be delayed.

4. Heard both sides.

5. Point that arise for consideration is:

1) Are there sufficient grounds to allow this petition ?

6. **Point No.1:-** According to the petitioner he intends to go Malaysia to visit his son who is studying at Malaysia. The petitioner has produced the copy of his passport which expired on 02/02/2026. Since the petitioner requires one year valid passport for issuing visa, I am of the view that he can be permitted to

renew the passport for a validity period of one year. So, this point is found in favour of the petitioner.

7. In the light of the discussions in point No.1 it is clear that there are sufficient grounds to allow the petitioner to renew his passport for a period of one year and the petition is liable to be allowed.

8. In the result, petition is allowed and permission is granted to the petitioner to renew his passport for a period of one year
