This Interlocutory Application is coming on this day for hearing before me in the presence of Sri.Eldose Mathew, Advocate for the petitioners and respondent not entered in appearance and the Court on the same day passed the following:-

ORDER

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner. Perused the affidavit and the documents on record. I am satisfied that a prima facie case has been made out. It appears that, if notice is issued to the opposite party before granting an injunction, the very object of granting such injunction would be defeated by the delay thereby caused. Hence, an ad interim prohibitory injunction is granted restraining the respondent and his men from selling, alienating, or transferring the plaint schedule property until further orders.

The petitioner shall comply with the proviso to Order XXXIX Rule 3 of the Code of Civil Procedure. Issue notice to the respondents. For return of notice: 02.06.2026.
